# HSIP - Feedback from Users

- 90% of users say that HSIP saves them time
  - 72% Filling out paperwork
  - 79% Routing
  - 65% Reconciliation
- HSIP Office has 100% satisfaction rating
  - 97% of users say the HSIP Office has exceptional customer service
  - 3% of users say the HSIP Office has above average customer service
- 99% Approval Rating
  - 65% of users say the HSIP exceeds their expectations.
  - 34% say HSIP meets their needs.
