

The Federal Funding Accountability and Transparency Act (FFATA)

- Requires information disclosure of entities receiving Federal funding through Federal awards such as Federal contracts and their subcontracts and Federal grants and their subgrants.
- Requires the establishment of a publicly available, searchable website (www.USAspending.gov) that contains information about each Federal award.

What new reporting is required?

- Prime contract awardees of contracts (non ARRA) must report associated contract subawards of \$25K or more.
- Data collection will be phased-in with all required contract subawards reporting by March 2011.
- Prime grant awardees of grants (non ARRA) awarded on or after October 1, 2010 must report associated grant subawards of \$25K or more.

FFATA Subaward Reporting System (FSRS)

- Prime awardees enter following sub-award information if not **pre-populated**:
 - Name of entity receiving award
 - Amount of award
 - Subcontract Number
 - Funding agency
 - CFDA Number (Grants)
 - NAICS (Contracts)
 - Treasury Account Symbol (Contracts)
 - Award title descriptive of the purpose of the funding action
 - Location of the entity (including congressional district)
 - Place of performance (including congressional district)
 - Unique identifier (e.g., DUNS) of the entity and its parent and DUNS +4 (Grants)
 - Total compensation and names of top five executives

DUNS & CCR NUMBERS

- Data Universal Numbering System (DUNS).
- Central Contractor Registration (CCR).
- All 1st tier subawardees issued under FFATA requirements must obtain a DUNS number prior to subaward.
- Obtaining a CCR number will make compliance with FFATA more efficient.
